Minutes of January 2020 meeting were read and approved. (Dan, Linda)

Public Comment

- Bill Mosey thanked the board for posting agenda on website. He also commented about Campbell Township Tax Assessor and blight ordinance example.
- -Steve Courter asked if board was aware that an Elmdale church is proposing to build a 250' cell tower in the Elmdale area. He voiced his opposition to the plan. Brian Thompson said that Campbell Township has no authority to accept or reject the plan since there is no zoning in our township.

Fire Department

- Paul reported that there were 17 fire calls and 180 hours put in by firemen in the past month.

- Working on some new gear.
- Donation of a Thermal Imaging camera from fire department fund raisers valued at \$5,517.80.

Park- Joe Fahrni asked about a fee for ball tournaments at the park. Motion by Brian, supported by Marshann to charge \$75 per day or \$125 for 2 days and \$50 per day for lights if used. Carried. Signups for ball teams are going on now.

Cemetery – Joe Fahrni plans to expand lean-to building so that tractor can be parked there. Several people volunteered to help.

Roads -Supervisor Brian reported that this year Clarksville Road will be crack-sealed from Clarksville Village limits to M-50. Bell Road Bridge is scheduled for 2022. Gravel contract for 3500 yards of gravel will be signed later when new budget is formulated.

Other Business –Board approved to get rid of old computer and technical equipment no longer used.
