New Business-

-motion approved to waive the 3% late fee for taxes paid after February 16 until March 1.

-Update on gravel and brine contracts. – Price will be same as last year. Prein and Newhof will be doing some managing of the Ionia County Road Department for the time being.

-Cemetery CD is coming due. Approved to renew for 12 months, then reassess.

-Fire Department – new turnout gear has been ordered. Paul reported there will be an emergency management grant for properly fitted N-95 masks for the fire department first responders. He will find out dollar amount.

-Approved application of Cody Stowell for 55 acres in PA 116.

Township Park – Brian reported that summer ball team sign-up is on hold. Sign up will probably take place through the Lake Odessa program.

-Port-a-Jon will be rented again for this summer. Park restrooms will remain closed until COVID-19 threat has passed.

Other Business-

Recycle program at Sunfield has been reopened by the Eaton County Resource Recovery group. Recycling is open to everyone regardless of residence and will be run for one year as a pilot program to see if there is enough regional interest to sustain the operation. The center is open on Wednesdays from 2-6 pm and Saturdays 9 am – 1 pm.

February Bills amounting to \$12,342.32 were approved for payment.
