March 10, 2022

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm.

Minutes of February meeting were read and approved (Dennis, Dan)

New Business:

-Representatives from United Bank were present to explain the SWEEP Accounts procedure at United Bank.

-Gina Johnson introduced herself as running for the 78th District (changed from 87th with redistricting) in Michigan. There will be a Meet and Greet on March 22 at the Clarksville Village Hall where residents can meet and talk with her.

Fire Chief Report.

- Officer election for the fire department resulted in the continuation of all present officers - Paul Immoos as Chief, Randy Willette as Assistant Chief, Bill Bird as Training Officer and Len Satterley as Maintenance Officer. Paul asked that wages for Officers be kept the same and Meeting wage be raised to \$30 per meeting attended.

-Downpayment of \$10,000 has been made for the new fire truck (see last month's minutes), customization of the truck will take another 6 months. Approximate due date is sometime in 2023. Old tanker truck will be sold.

-Frontline will be coming to do maintenance on some of the fire vehicles.

Resolution to grant purchase of a new fire truck was presented. Motion by Dan, supported by Dennis to approve and sign the resolution. Roll Call vote: Pepper, Jackson, Thompson, Ludema, Willison - all ayes. Carried

Resolution to accept Metro Act Point Broadband proposal - motion by Dennis, support by Dan to accept and sign resolution. Roll Call vote - Thompson, Pepper, Jackson, Ludema, Willison - all ayes.

Old Business

Blight Discussion - Dennis has been doing some research into what neighboring townships and municipalities are doing with the blight issue. He recommended that we look into it further, specifically, the purpose of a nuisance ordinance versus a blight ordinance. Any language formulated for a ballot proposal will be distributed within the township by inclusion with summer tax bills, website, and posting at township hall, etc. before the November election.

Financial Report - motion made to accept the financial report by Dan, support by Dennis. Carried. Note that any funds intended for gravel will be transferred into General Fund Savings until they are needed.

Bills totaling \$11,143.32 were approved for payment. (Dennis, Dan)
