Fire Report – Front Line was here for 1201 maintenance – waiting for a part for that truck; Pump tests went well; old ice water suits will be sold, West Shore was here for flow tests, all passed; fire hose samples have arrived along with a hose/nozzle demo; there will be a two-day training the end of June for the fire volunteers.

Supervisor items – Brian has received a PA 116 application from Ron and Martin Hoeksma for section 36 of Campbell Township. Motion was made to approve by Dennis, support by Dan. Carried

Old Business – Linda talked to Dave Dorn about his health concerns because of dust on Peddler Lake Rd. Best way to insure that road continues to be brined as needed is for Mr. Dorn to talk to Fisher/Idema (the gravel pit business) and ask that they keep the road brined as needed to keep dust down. Campbell Township will also contact Fisher/Idema with the request.

- Junk Ordinance – discussed amending the existing 1956 ordinance, updating and cleaning it up to include more detail. We'll consult with Boston Township at some point.
